



Tenant Participation Frequently Asked Questions

What does the Tenant Participation Team do?

We are committed to providing a quality tenant participation service to all, allowing you to be involved in your housing services – as an individual or as a member of a group.

How much will it cost to get involved?

We believe that as volunteers there should be no cost in getting involved with GGHT, therefore GGHT covers out of pocket expenses. These payments do not affect any benefits you may claim.

What is the time commitment?

Time commitment varies for each individual. We believe that people should be involved at a level that suits them and can get involved as much or as little as they wish.

How do I set up a Tenants & Residents Association?

The GGHT Tenant Participation Team can give advice to groups wanting to set up an association and supports existing Associations. The team will give advice on training and funding as well as providing support in actually setting up an Association.
