- Obtain information on housing services of special interest to disabled residents
- Monitor the Council's performance in relation to housing services for disabled residents and suggest ways of improving services.
- Meet other disabled tenants from across the borough

If you can't get to meetings you can still get involved by becoming an associate member. These members will be sent copies of the agendas and minutes and will be able to suggest agenda items and submit questions to the Panel.
